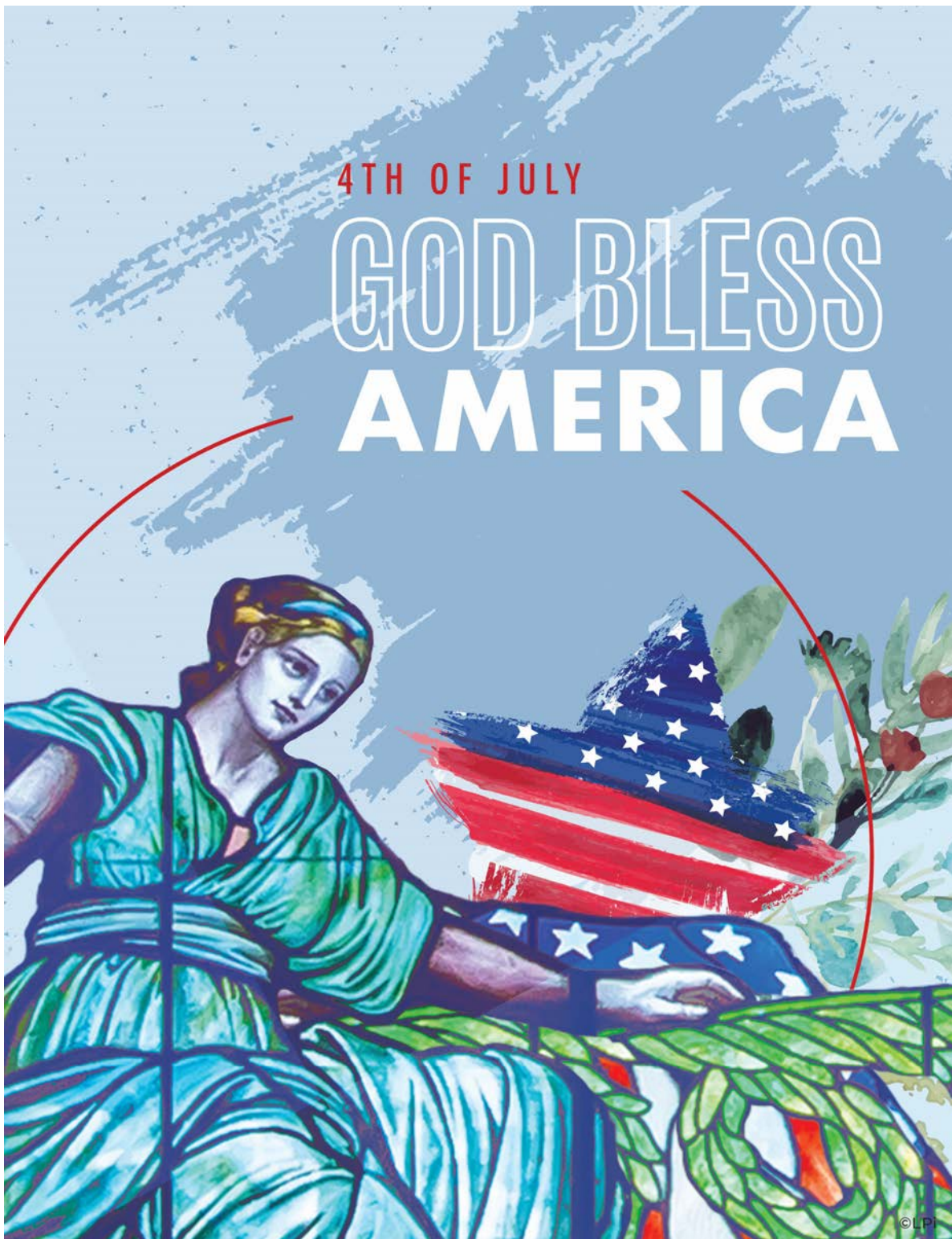

**BAPTISM OF INFANTS** Baptisms are usually celebrated on the first and third Sundays of each month (except during Lent) at 11:00 AM. A Baptism Preparation Class must be attended if you are planning your first child's baptism or if three years have passed since your last child was baptized. Call the Parish Office to register and to check whether adjustments have been made to the schedule.

**MARRIAGE** Marriage arrangements must be made at least six months in advance by contacting the Parish Office to set the date and reserve the church. Reserve the church before you reserve the reception hall.

## Creation Care Corner

Nearly half of the energy used in your home goes to heating & cooling. Making smart decisions about your home's heating, & air conditioning can have a big effect on your utility bills. Cooling tips include:

- Cover windows with drapes or shades especially on south and west facing windows.
- Weather-strip doors and windows, then add adequate insulation to keep the heat out.
- Maintain home HVAC equipment & change filters. Programmable thermostats save money.
- During the hottest part of the day, turn off the stove, dishwasher, lights, etc. Also, consider turning up the thermostat temperature several degrees.
- If your AC is old, consider replacing with an Energy Star System. replacing it with a highly efficient heat pump will work for you (which can both heat and cool your home). For more info:
